



# project services case study

Six Flags Fiesta Texas  
San Antonio, TX

This 5.4 acre project is an expansion to the already existing six-acre waterpark ADG constructed in the spring of 1992. Both are incorporated within the Fiesta Texas Amusement Park and the day's admission price includes entrance to the waterpark.

The new expansion features a massive WaveTek® wave pool that is shaped like the state of Texas. It is surrounded by an extensive array of artificial rockwork as well as natural rock. A cascading waterfall is designed as to gently fall into the pool. A treehouse play structure and family activity area are also incorporated into the addition.

The original waterpark's 1,200 LF adventure river is heavily themed and includes wave channels, white water rapids, waterfalls, grottos, geyser islands and cavernous switchbacks along its journey.

A 4,000 sq/ft multi-level children's play area and ten waterslides including a 4-man raft ride completes the waterpark.

The wave pool, as well as the rest of the park, is filtered with Whitten® High Rate Sand Filters.
