WHO BUYS A FLOWRIDER®?

The four main markets are hotels & resorts, waterparks, municipalities, stand-alone facilities such as surf shops, restaurants, cruise ships, private residences and shopping malls.

WHAT MAKES THE FLOWRIDER® DIFFERENT FROM ALL OTHER WATERPARK ATTRACTIONS?

Skill is not a requirement for most waterparks. There is no learning curve or challenge to going down a slide. Although it is exciting, over time, the excitement diminishes.

Riding a FlowRider takes skill, balance and most importantly, practice. The adrenaline rush of becoming a better flowboarder with every try inspires patrons to achieve a never-ending cycle of skill-based reward. That learning curve takes time and dedication, thereby increasing rider visitations and loyalty.

The FlowRider has a coolness factor that allows any venue to connect with the extremely popular board-riding lifestyle that includes surfing, skateboarding, wakeboarding, skimboarding and snowboarding.

Spectators also end up having

a great time just being near the FlowRider! It is sheer entertainment that sets our ride apart. When orchestrated correctly, the crowd of spectators will generate increased revenues through food, beverage and retail sales.

HOW DOES THE FLOWRIDER® WORK?

Submersive propeller pumps located in the pool below inject a three-inch sheet of water over the engineered ride surface creating a surfable wave. The resulting wave-like shape permits flowboarders of all ages and skill level to surf the wave face.

IS THE FLOWRIDER® SIMILAR TO A WAVE POOL?

No, the FlowRider is not a wave pool. Traditional wave pools use paddles, plungers, pressure or gravity to pulse a mass of water through a large body of water. Wave pools are



designed to put as many riders as possible on that dissipating wave of energy.

A FlowRider sheet wave is an endless wave which pumps thousands of gallons of water over a composite membrane riding surface, creating a perfect perpetual wave.

WHO DOES THE FLOWRIDER® APPEAL TO?

The FlowRider appeals to people of all ages, especially teens. Learning to ride the FlowRider, or the act of flowboarding, is a skill-based activity. It provides the antidote to thrill fatigue in young children and teens as riders challenge themselves to learn the skill which drives spectatorship and repeat visitation.

WHAT IS FLOW?

We have created the sport of flowboarding, the guidelines for the sport, and the process for the competitive landscape. Annually the FLOW (Flowboarding League Of The World) Tour sanctions and facilitates 30+ competitions globally.

IS THE FLOWRIDER® SAFE?

Absolutely! The FlowRider's waveform is a proprietary tensioned ride surface. It is similar to a trampoline and designed to absorb the energy of impacts. Our latest innovation, "Pillow Padding," pads the recovery zones for easier landing. Now when pros and novices inevitably wipe out, not only is the ride surface going to support the fall, but so will the recovery areas.

ARE PATRONS ALLOWED TO STAND-UP RIDE ON THE FLOWRIDER®?

Stand-up riding is permitted if the patron signs the official FlowRider Voluntary Acknowledgement of Risks, Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement and has once before ridden the FlowRider in the prone position (a.k.a. bodyboarded on a FlowRider previously).

WHAT BOARDS DO YOU USE?

There are two types of boards: bodyboard and flowboard, both of which have been designed specifically for the FlowRider.

WHAT IS THE CAPACITY OF THE FLOWRIDER®?

There are two types of capacity: Active Capacity and Passive Capacity.

Active Capacity. The FlowRider has an average capacity of 160 riders per hour. The FlowRider Double is 320 persons.

Passive Capacity. Spectators love watching people ride the FlowRider, from the pratfalls of the inexperienced to the kickflips of the pros. The entertainment value of this attraction makes it the perfect anchor for auxiliary revenue sources.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO INSTALL?

Approximately six months from start to finish.

CAN THE FLOWRIDER® BE INSTALLED INDOORS?

Yes, there are FlowRiders installed in many indoor waterparks, shopping malls and surf shops. However, it is important to remember that a very substantial Heating Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) system will be



required and need to be accounted for.

CAN THE WATER BE HEATED?

There is no problem with heating the water in the FlowRider. (Although that should be performed by a local pool contractor.)

WHAT IS THE LIFESPAN OF A FLOWRIDER®?

The very first FlowRider was installed at Schlitterbahn Waterpark & Resorts in Texas, in 1991 and is still up and running successfully! Since then we have built over 220+ worldwide!

HOW MUCH POWER DOES THE FLOWRIDER® USE?

The FlowRider Compact uses

75kW, the FlowRider Single uses 90kW and the FlowRider Double uses 180kW.

WHAT IS A FLOWRIDER® COVE?

A FlowRider Cove is a two-for-one water ride attraction that brings you all the excitement and skill-based action of a FlowRider combined with the fun and thrills of a wave pool. Or if you're looking to build a complete surfing mecca consider a Boogie Boarding Wave pool instead! Designed to be a complete destination experience, FlowRider Cove allows you to truly capture the beach lifestyle.
